Later in the day, all Shoreline Cleanup volunteers are invited to join us for a free picnic cookout sponsored by the Friends of Dale Hollow Lake, Inc. The picnic will be held at the Dale Hollow Dam Recreation Area shelter at 1:00 PM, and free door prizes will be awarded to the cleanup volunteers. **All door prize winners must be present to win.**
