## Dale Hollow Lake Announces Shoreline Cleanup

**CELINA, TENN, [Sept. 7, 2004]** — The summer of 2004 is winding down with the approach of Labor Day, and the coves and shorelines of Dale Hollow Lake offer a sad testament to the overwhelming popularity of this beautiful natural resource. By this time each year, bottles, cans, tires, and styrofoam cups now mar the spectacular scenery of many natural areas around the lake.

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and The Friends of Dale Hollow Lake, Inc., are again making plans to help restore the shoreline's natural beauty by sponsoring the annual Shoreline Cleanup on Saturday, September 25.

You are invited to join both organizations and take part in this annual event. The Shoreline Cleanup offers individuals an opportunity to participate in a beneficial outdoor activity and demonstrate support for the environmental.

The Shoreline Cleanup will begin at 8 a.m. Check-in stations for volunteers will be in four locations: Pleasant Grove Recreation Area, Obey River Recreation Area, Lillydale Recreation Area, and at the Dale Hollow State Resort Park Marina. Trash bags will be provided.

After a morning of collecting litter, all volunteers are invited to stay for a free picnic cookout sponsored by the Friends of Dale Hollow Lake, Inc. The picnic will begin at the Dale Hollow Dam Recreation Area shelter at 1 p.m., and door prizes will be awarded to cleanup volunteers. Sunset Marina in Byrdstown, Tenn., has donated the Grand Prize, a 4-Day houseboat rental that one lucky volunteer will enjoy.
