**SUBJECT: Closure of Kentucky Lock at Tennessee River Mile 22.4 and Barkley Lock Cumberland
River Mile 30.6**

Kentucky Lock at TRM 22.4

The lock will be closed to navigation to make an underwater inspection with Corps of Engineer divers on the poiree dam shoes, underwater anchorage of the structure. The closure will be on January 10, 2006 for an 8 to 10 hour period, during daylight hours. The lock will be in operation all other hours to pass traffic.

The alternate waterway is via Barkley Lock and Barkley Canal will be available to pass traffic.

Barkley Lock at CRM 22.4

The lock will be closed to navigation to make an underwater inspection with Corps of Engineer divers on the poiree dam shoes, underwater anchorage of the structure. The closure will be on January 11 2006 for an 8 to 10 hour period, during daylight hours. The lock will be in operation all other hours to pass traffic.

The alternate waterway is via Kentucky Lock and Barkley Canal will be available to pass traffic

Operators of all craft are requested to contact Barkley and Kentucky Locks well in advance of arrival for instructions.
