**SUBJECT: Bank Stabilization Activities in the Vicinity of Cumberland River Mile 189.0,
Right Bank**

Choctaw Transportation will begin bank stabilization activities at the subject location on Monday, 23 January 2006. Floating plant will be placing rip-rap stone along the right bank from a point approximately 150 feet below the Lyle M. Fulton Highway Bridge to a point approximately 150 foot above the bridge. Activities will be conducted during daylight hours until its completion in approximately two weeks. Equipment will be moored on-site along the right bank during non-working hours. Vessel operators are requested to reduce speed and use additional care when transiting this area.
