SUBJECT: Repair of Federal Mooring Facility, Cumberland River Mile 32.5

Southern Marine Construction will begin repair of mooring cells located along the left channel limits at the subject location on or about 6 February 2006. Work will be conducted between during daylight hours, Monday through Friday, until completed in approximately thirty (30) days. Equipment will consist of the M/V ELIZABETH YATES, a 130' x 32' crane-barge, a 120' x 30' deck barge, and other related equipment. During non-working hours, the equipment will be moored on-site.

During this period, this facility is closed and traffic is prohibited from landing or mooring on the mooring cells or the floating plant engaged in the repair activities. Questions regarding the status of the facility can be addressed to the Lockmaster at Barkley Lock via marine radio or telephone.

Vessels transiting this area should hold a safe distance off the floating plant to eliminate the risk of damage or injury caused by their wake.

Additional notices will be issued as conditions warrant.
