

SUBJECT: Construction of Loading Facility with Steel Sheet Pile Cells and Mooring Dolphins, Cumberland River Mile 16.7, Right Bank and Fleeting Area with Steel Sheet Pile Cells and Mooring Dolphins, Cumberland River Mile 17.2 Left Bank

Southern Marine Construction Company of Chattanooga, Tennessee will begin construction of the subject river terminal and fleeting area on June 4, 2007 and will continue for approximately seven months or until completion. The contractor will work during daylight hours only Monday through Friday.

The equipment will consist of two 195'x35' crane barges, two 195'x35' deck barges, one 195'x35' hopper barge, the M/V ELIZABETH YATES, and the M/V TRAILBLAZER. The equipment will remain on site throughout the construction and properly lighted. The working vessels will be monitoring channel 13 if contact is required.
