**SUBJECT: Construction of Two Steel Sheet Pile Mooring Cells, Tennessee River Mile 296.7, Left Descending Bank**

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers have begun construction of two 30' diameter mooring cells at the subject location. These cells will be just downstream of the entrance to the Morgan County Port channel at Tennessee River Mile 297.0.

This work will continue for approximately seven weeks or until completion. The equipment will consist of the D

Derrickboat BINKLEY, M/V IROQUOIS, and several equipment barges. The equipment will remain onsite throughout the construction and properly lighted during nonworking hours.

Pilots on all vessels are urged to exercise caution when transiting this reach of the waterway and reduce speed to control wake. If needed the M/V IROQUOIS can be contacted on channels 13 or 16 of the marine radio.
