SUBJECT: Repairs to R. J. Corman Railroad Bridge, Cumberland River Mile 126.5.

Scott Bridge Company has begun conducting repairs to the pier for the left fixed span of the subject bridge. During these repairs, barges will be moored around the pier to provide a floating working area and support for equipment. Repairs are schedule to be conducted 7 days-a-week between the hours of 5am and 5pm, until repairs have been completed. Repairs are expected to be completed no later than 31 August 2007.

The US Coast Guard has restricted vessels not engaged in the repair activities from entering the immediate area around this pier. Also, the previous restriction for the size of tows passing through this bridge is still in effect.

During these repairs, navigation traffic can still utilize the right swing span to transit this area. Vessel operators are requested to be mindful of their vessel's wake and take appropriate measures to minimize its affect on the repair activities when transiting this area.

Additional notices will be issued as conditions warrant.
