SUBJECT: Repairs to the CSX Railroad Bridge, Cumberland River Mile 190.4

Southern Marine Construction Company, Chattanooga, Tennessee will begin repairs to the damaged guard pier on December 10, 2007. The repairs will be performed during daylight hours, Monday through Friday. Completion of the project is expected to be within four months.

The equipment will consist of a 150'x54' crane barge, a 195'x35' deck barge, a 200'x35' hopper barge, the M/V ELIZABETH YATES, and the M/V J. E. POTTER. Operators will be able to contact the M/V J. E. POTTER on channel 13 during working hours to inquire about passing instructions. During nonworking hours the equipment will be moored along the left descending bank and properly lighted.

In the interest of safety to both personnel and equipment pilots on all vessels are urged to reduce speed and exercise caution when passing the work site.
