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Foundation Grouting begins at Wolf Creek Dam

NASHVILLE, TENN. (December 14, 2006) – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Nashville District, announced today that task orders to date in the amount of \$14 million have been issued to Advanced Construction Techniques, LTD, of Toronto, Canada, to begin the foundation grouting process. The total cost of the ACT, LTD contract for foundation grouting is \$51 million. Another contract was awarded Sept. 12 to VCI-Doyon JV, of Knoxville, Tenn., in the amount of \$8 million for the Halcomb's Landing Relocation. The completion date for this work is scheduled for October 2007. In addition, the contract for the cutoff wall will be advertised in June 2007 and awarded in December 2007. These contracts currently in place are on schedule and are a vital element in resolving seepage issues at the Dam.

A decision about possible pool modifications based on the ongoing Risk Reduction Study is planned for mid to late January as part of a the risk management program designed to ensure the safety of the public.
