

BUOYS AND CHANNEL MARKING

- Increased marking of secondary channels and underwater hazards.
- Simplify the buoy system by using more basic “danger” buoys. Too many buoys and colors can be confusing.
- Place explicit warnings on buoys. Little River needs immediate hazard assessment.
- Place solar lights on buoys so they can be easily seen in low light conditions.
- Develop a system by which the public can report missing or damaged buoys. The need to know how/where to report any problems – *also covered under Signage and Mapping*.
- Increase the use of regulatory buoys in areas of heavy use, specifically Green Turtle Bay (reduce speed).
