The current shoreline management plan has been in effect since May 2000. The plan details Corps policies related to issuing permits for private docks, land use privileges, and general guidelines.

Copies of the updated plan and allocation maps will be available to the public for their review at both meetings. Also, the Cheatham Resource Management Staff will be available to further discuss the proposed changes to the Lakeshore Management Plan or individuals concerns.

Cheatham's boundaries extend 67.5 miles up the Cumberland River from Cheatham Dam to Old Hickory Dam (320 miles of shoreline).
