Joe C. Davis YMCA Resident Camp Public Meeting

NASHVILLE, TENN., (July 27, 2005) - The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Nashville District, will hold a public meeting August 4th at the Hermitage Library as part of the process to consider a request from the YMCA of Middle Tennessee.

The meeting, scheduled from 5:30 to 7:00 p.m., is designed to allow the public to submit comments and issues related to the environmental review of the proposed change which will allow day use and limited residential overnight camping and a 25-year lease extension to the Metropolitan Development and Housing Agency (MDHA).

Joe C. Davis YMCA Outdoor Center is currently under lease from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to MDHA, who subleases to the YMCA of Middle Tennessee. It consists of 320 acres along the scenic shoreline of J. Percy Priest Lake. It is located off Smith Springs Road.

Interested parties may attend the meeting at the Hermitage Library, 3700 James Kay Lane (between Dodson Chapel Road and Central Pike) to provide comments either verbally or in writing and they may also mail such comments to the address below.
