Construction Begins on Halcomb's Landing Project

Nashville, Tenn. (March 29, 2006) — The firm RCI, Inc., from Lexington, Ky., has been awarded the contract for clearing and excavation to construct a haul road and clear land for the eventual relocation of the access road, parking lot and boat ramp at Halcomb's Landing on Lake Cumberland.

This work is currently in progress and precedes the Major Rehabilitation Contract for the Wolf Creek Dam Embankment. The existing parking lot and boat ramp area will become the contractor's staging area for the repair work on the embankment.

Blasting will be necessary to accomplish the work and will require temporary closure of the access area. Appropriate signs and road blocks will be erected to notify users of blasting times and closures. These temporary closures are required to provide for public safety and can be expected from the first or second week in April until May 31. Blasting will not be allowed on Saturday and Sunday during the month of May. Please cooperate with the posted requirements as vehicles/trailers will be towed if necessary so that work can be accomplished in a safe and efficient manner.
