**B.** Typical year assessment(s): The Antecedent Precipitation Tool (APT) calculated that August, the date of site visit, occurred during a 2 1.2 month of above average precipitation. The Output indicates that the date of the site visit was a wetter than normal year with the Palmer Drought Severity Index (PDSI) stating "Extreme Wetness," and WebWIMP indicating Dry Season. Observed value for rainfall on the date of the site visit was within the above 30-Year Normal range. The Antecedent Condition Calculation was 17; indicating that the condition was Wetter than Normal using 4 weather stations less than 15 miles from the project site.
