

MEMORANDUM FOR Nashville District (LRN) Operations Managers and Natural Resources Managers

SUBJECT: Policy on the use of Golf Carts and Low and Medium Speed Vehicles on public roadways in Corps operated recreation areas.

1. References.

a. Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Chapter III, Part 327.2 and Part 327.26.

b. Title 49 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) - Transportation, Part 571 - Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards, Section 500 - Low-speed vehicles.

c. EM 385-1-1 USACE Safety and Health Requirements Manual, 30 November 2014.

d. Title 55 - Motor and Other Vehicles, Tenn. Code Ann. §§, 55-1-103, 55-1-122, 55-1-123, 55-4-111, 55-8-101, 55-8-191 and 55-50-102.

e. Title XVI - Motor Vehicles, Kentucky Statutes, Chapters 186, and 189.

2. Applicability. This policy applies to all Nashville District Civil Works Projects where Title 36 C.F.R. is applicable.

3. Policy. All vehicle use on public roadways administered by the Corps of Engineers shall be in accordance with all Federal, state and local laws and ordinances. Vehicles shall also be operated in accordance with posted restrictions and regulations.

a. In accordance with 36 C.F.R. § 327.2(a), the term vehicle includes, but is not limited to, automobiles, trucks, motorcycles, mini-bikes, snowmobiles, dune buggies, all-terrain vehicles (ATVs), and trailers, campers, bicycles, or any other such equipment. Other such equipment would include golf carts and low and medium speed type vehicles.

b. The use of golf carts and low and medium speed type



vehicles is permitted on roadways in Corps operated recreation areas. However, these type vehicles shall be operated in accordance with applicable Federal, state and local laws, which shall be regulated by authorized enforcement officials as prescribed in 36 C.F.R. § 327.26.

c. In accordance with 36 C.F.R. § 327.2(c), the operation and/or parking of a vehicle off authorized roadways is prohibited except at locations and times designated by the District Commander.
