REVIEW AREA ONLY INCLUDES DRY LAND: In the submitted S&ME, Jurisdictional Waters Report Innovation Park, Johnson City, Washington County, Tennessee, S&ME Project No. 200926, dated May 10, 2022, it was documented that there are no aquatic resources or potential aquatic resources in the 60-acre review area that would warrant the application of a wetland delineation, significant nexus analysis, navigability determination, and/or delineation of the ebb and flow of the tides.
